xpectations come highly recommended before God can work wonders in your life, in fact you cannot do without it to feel the hand of God. People ordinarily have expectations but I'm referring to the one that is anchored on the Almighty and trusts Him as being able to do that which He promised to do or exactly what you are looking up to Him for. It is when this is the case that you can have an end to your longing and thine expectation shall not be cut off as Proverbs 23:18 puts it. Expectation is the key to manifestation. Experience is not a sudden occurrence for it is a given that what you expect that you experience.

Hebrews 11:1 tells us that: faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. Hope here refers to expectation or anticipation. As powerful as faith is, it cannot call things, which are not in existence without hope. You can have faith but once expectation is missing, that mountain won't move. In fact, expectations inspire faith for there can be no faith when there is no anticipation. As it were, expectations find expression in faith. Thankfully, there is a way to generate expectations even when there are none. This is by consistently confessing those things you want to happen and allowing your imagination to run wild.

The truth is that when you are hopeful, shame is far removed from you. Romans 5:5 makes it clear that hope maketh not ashamed. Attracting great things just by having expectation is so efficacious that people who are not even Christians, apply same principle and come away with tremendous results. Barrack Obama wrote a book he titled: The Audacity of Hope. He did not quote scripture in the book but was positing that there is a tremendous power when you anticipate to be something in life. The now former President of the United States posited in the offering that he expected to be America's President and turned out to be same.

Don't let the negative events that have trailed this year dampen your hope. Let your expectations for a better tomorrow come alive. Don't pray if you don't have hope. Mark 11:24 says: Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them. Believe as used here there is actually talking about hope just as "desire" mentioned in the scripture points to expectation. When you anticipate results, they will definitely come. In 1 Kings 18:41-46, Elijah was on the mountain after prophesying that it shall rain in Israel which by his word had not had rain for over three years. His expectation of rain was so high that did not mind his servant's message of no sign of rain, but sent him seven times to check the weather for a sign of rain. The Prophet of God was like: "I am praying for rain, and rain I must see". This great anticipation finally paid off with verse 45 telling that: Now it happened in the meantime that the sky became black with clouds and wind, and there was a heavy rain. So Ahab rode away and went to Jezreel.

The story of the woman with the issue of blood in Matthew 9 is also a study in expectation and a testament of how it inspires faith into delivering results. Her expectation made her to discountenance the fact that she was not supposed to be in the public and mingle with people.

According to verse 20 and 21: a woman, which was diseased with an issue of

blood twelve years, came behind him, and touched the hem of his garment for who willed in her heart: If I may but touch his garment, I shall be whole. This is expectation in action and it got her the kind of result that made Jesus Christ to celebrate her.

Aside the determination which expectation provoke, it can equally lead you to prepare just as Amos 4:12b said: prepare to meet thy God. Heaven is eager to grant your heart desire but the question is: Are you ready? Every day is God's day, the day your faith comes alive is your own day. God is ever ready. The psalmist called Him the ever present help. There is no doubting the fact that once we are ready, God is. Proverbs 16:1 says: The preparations of the heart in man, and the answer of the tongue, is from the Lord and Luke 14:17 asserts that He has sent his servant at supper time to say to those who were invited, 'Come, for all things are now ready'.

Beloved, it is your expectation leading to your preparation that will gain you a seat in this supper where everything is ready. As an exercise of the foregoing teaching, the next page contains some prophecies and declarations which came from the Most High during the just-ended Recharge Conference. Build your expectations around the much you can and apply all you've learnt from this article to them. Get ready for 'Something Big' in Jesus name, Amen!

HIGHLANDERS SHOULD SEEK GOD LIKE PEOPLE WHO HAVE CAUGHT FIRE – PASTOR KINGSLEY

Pastor Segun Kingsley was our guest minister at the Recharge Conference 2020. Based in the United Kingdom, the widely-travelled revivalist is called of God and enjoys His unusual favour across various areas of life. Pastor Kingsley is a product of God's mercy and sees himself as "doing a catchup with God in some of the things I am experiencing in life. I have seen God take me through some steps I am running after. This is what I mean by doing catchup". Below are excerpts of an interview he granted after ministering for three days during the recently-held Recharge Conference 2020.

How did you get to this point where God is using you so mightily?

The scripture says the path of the righteous shineth brighter and brighter. The walk with God is a daily affair. The more you try to know God, the more you realize that there is so much you are yet to know. So what I do is to be consistent in finding God. When the scripture calls God a mystery, that's the totality of who God is. It's like when you are trying to see a colour. You'll realize that the shade you saw 1kilometre away is actually different from what you see while coming closer. I used to think I prayed earlier in life but when I look back now, I see what I was doing then as a child's play. Even now that I think I've understood prayer, I'm sure that in the next 10 years, the dimension of prayer I will be experiencing will be different.

What level of sacrifice have you made to attain this level with God?

There is no end to that as you can find in the scripture, which is the manual for every child of God. The scripture says that Jesus prayed all through the night so as to preach. This means that if every child of God and every pastor learn to spend time in the place of prayer, mysteries will be unveiled unto us. People think I read the Bible a lot when I want to preach, but you will be amazed to know that the Bible is last thing I use while preparing to preach but I pray like that is the last preaching I have to deliver. When you have an understanding that people you are ministering to require something new anytime you'd have to preach to them, you can't go and be preaching old notes. For me, I first hear from God clearly. It is after this that I start searching the bible for passages that relate to what God has said.

How do you quantify the time a preacher should spend in the place of prayer before ministering?

Bible scholars say that for every 30 or 33 minutes Jesus preached, he spent three hours in prayers, but I do not follow that. God determines when I come and when I go. I'm coming to my son's church, so it's not a preaching thing. Anybody can preach but not everybody leaves a deposit. God did not put blessings in the mouth of everybody. When you come to the consciousness that you must not fail God regarding those the Lord have put in your hands, you can't determine that you want to pray for three hours or one hour. God knocked off the original message I planned to preach on Saturday and today. So, it was a new message that I ended up preaching. You don't get that if you are not in the place of prayer. There are websites where people can download sermons. So anybody can preach. But you must realize that there is a difference between preaching, a father's blessing and an



apostolic work.

What difference have you noticed in Highland Church between when you visited in July and now?

What I have noticed are in two folds: God has been faithful to you as a church and God has been extremely good to you as a church. However, from the pastor to the least person, you mustn't see yourself in the scheme of things. It is purely God. Always return all commendations you get for your progress to God. I've seen a lot of tremendous progress, I've seen the Church grow but you've not even started. You have not seen anything yet.

What does Highland Church need to do to get to the top and achieve her lofty vision?

You keep running and working. You must work like 24 hours is not enough. What I usually tell anybody who cares to listen is that you are not running a race with anybody. The day you start saying that you run better than that person is when you start going down. So, learn to compete with yourself and you will get better by the day. One of the things I do is that I always ask myself: what did I do better yesterday so that I can improve on it.

Given how powerful the Recharge Conference was, what should members do to sustain the fire and power they've received?

All you need to do is to continue working with all you've received in the last five days and ensure that the fire is ignited every day. There are two things that happen to fire. When you keep fanning it, it keeps glowing but when you don't, it keeps producing ashes and after a while the whole fire goes out. With this Recharge Conference, members of Highland Church should not just be coming to church; they should be coming to church like people who have caught fire and are ready to burn any devil around. You are coming to church loaded and to collect another one. When I say ignite fire, it is the Word that will be ignited in you. As you're hearing the Word, you are getting contagious. As prophetic declarations are coming, you allow the Word of God to fuel you. You get more fuel by consistently coming to the Presence of the Lord. The Bible says as long as they sought God in the days of Zachariah, the prophet, God made them to prosper. So you can't collect fire and go sit down at the home. You must seek God continually.
