hanksgiving to God is not just about singing praises; it's an attitude that must start from the inside before showing on the outside. It is an attitude of gratitude and an acknowledgement of the kindness of God upon your life. Thanksgiving is like the typical receipt which acknowledges that a bill has been cleared. When you take note of the goodness of God upon your life, He is pleased and gets spurred to endow you with more benefits. Thanksgiving goes with praises; a person who has not acknowledged God's benevolence in his life cannot earnestly praise the Lord. Even when such a person praises God, it will be wishy-washy because on the inside, he is yet to acknowledge the good works of the Lord upon his life.

Thanksgiving preserves the blessings we receive from God. If Ecclesiastics 3:14 can state that whatsoever God doeth, it *shall be for ever,* how come the divine blessings some people receive do not endure? There have been instances of believers recording breakthroughs only for them to become broke a while later. Another may have received healing only for the sickness to make a comeback in no time. The answer to such puzzle lies in those believers' attitude to gratitude. When you don't thank God for those things you consider small blessings, you cannot receive bigger ones. God does not lift people up only to let them go down.

Malachi 2:2 warns that: *If ye will not hear, and if ye will not lay it to heart to give glory unto my name. I will even send a curse upon you, and I will curse your blessings: yea, I have cursed them already, because ye do not lay it to heart.* This shows that it is risky for people to praise God with their mouth in a manner that does not align with the state of their heart. As this scripture enjoins, adopt an attitude of gratitude to God so that the blessings from above which you are rejoicing about does not turn into a curse.

Thanksgiving is more about what's laid in your heart than the praises you sing. You may not be where you aspire but you are definitely not where you used to be. Be like David who can assert that: my soul doth magnify the Lord. Count your blessings one after the other and you would indeed be surprised at how much God has done for you. Doing this will equally make you realize that you are actually owing God thanks.

By being grateful to God, you get enabled to carry out things which are considered impossible. John 11:17 presents a difficult situation of a man who has been dead for four days yet raised to life. The siblings who were close to Jesus had lost hope so much so that *Martha*, the sister of him that was dead, saith unto him, Lord, by this time he stinketh: for he hath been dead four days. In the face of this difficult pass which even made the Lord weep, Jesus lifted up his eyes, and declared in verse 41b: *Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me.* This case of Lazarus who has been dead for four day was indeed tough and faith-challenging. However, Jesus went about addressing it by first thanking God before uttering the command. The right order is to begin by thanking God before commanding our world, not the other way round which many are wont to take. This is why they do not get answers to their prayers.

When he was done thanking God, the bible records that Jesus cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth and according to John 11: 44: *he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.* Beloved, learn to first thank God in the face of every situation and that intractable issue you want settled will answer to your command in Jesus name.
