

rise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee, so reads Isaiah 60:1. Darkness is the raw material for light to shine; light uses darkness to announce its presence. "Speed of light" as an expression aptly captures the alacrity with which darkness fizzles out whenever light seeks to happen on the scene. Darkness can't stand or withstand light. This has been the case since the very beginning as affirmed in John 1:5,the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

The point needs to be made that the light in reference is not the one from the elements – Sun, moon or stars. This light is the knowledge and understanding which opens the eyes of our mind to never-before-seen winning ideas and strategies. It is when this light illuminates our mind that we can gain access to *treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places* talked about in Isaiah 45:3.

This light can equally make you a solution provider who will be highly sought after to illuminate the dense darkness covering the earth and the gross darkness which is upon the people. The good news is that the grossness and density of the darkness cannot resist your light. Isaiah 60:3 assures that the Gentiles shall come to thy light, and kings to the brightness of thy rising.

How then can you call down this light? This can only happen in the place of

prayer. Not just your regular day-time prayer but the vigil variant. That is praying in the dead of the night unto the wee hours of the morning. Just as we have established that light likes coming up when there is darkness, that is how you will kindle this light when you pray in the dead of the night and during the day.

Night season is revelation and encounter season if you keep the watch. Open yourself up to God for inspiration and as you pray in the Holy Ghost, he will tell you steps to take. Use the wee hours of the morning to inquire from the Lord what He will have you do and His light will shine upon you. Embark on vigil prayers for your progress, telling God that there must be a way out of whatever difficult situation you're grappling with. Proclaim to the hearing of darkness your repulsion to remaining small and not making breakthrough and the Lord will honour your declaration.

Tell the Holy Ghost that you're open to ideas on what to do to succeed in life. As you pray in the Holy Ghost in this dead of the night, have a pen and jotter to write down what God will be unveiling to you for He will surely illuminate your mind with ideas. Use the day time to execute what you received during your night prayer time and you will see yourself recording giant strides.

To be even more successful, undertake this vigil for seven days. When you're done, your note will be filled with revelations. The Holy Ghost, as a Master Strategist, won't just tell you what to do but will reveal winning strategies. He can also point you to where you've been getting it wrong. And by the time you implement this light, kings shall come to the brightness of your rising.

The ideas you will receive from this kind of prayers are the sort that can grow your organization which if shared with the management will automatically make you their toast and most valuable employee.

Set a time to commune with God in the middle of the night and you will wake up with outstanding ideas. If you do this, He will show up right on time by waking you from sleep. You can't sleep all night and expect to win all day. If you stay awake all night you will win all day. This win will be as a result of your implementation of the ideas you received while seeking the face of God.

This is how to vanish darkness and use same for your rising. There is something called "Thy light", go on and access it in the place of midnight prayer and let it shine!

Law-Abiding Highland Church

Highland Church has re-arranged the sitting arrangement in her auditorium in line with the physical distancing expectation of the present time. This evidence just like teller and POS print outs can be brought to the altar on the first-fruits Sunday to be lifted before God who sees in secret and rewards in the open. You can also write and present a cheque that day.
