

od is interested in "the place" and makes provision for where His people should dwell. This is because His good intentions for them are only accessible when they are where He has provided for them. It is not only public authorities that carve out GRA. There is also God Reserved Area (GRA) which is for God's people to inhabit. This GRA can be seen in 2 Samuel 7:10 where the Lord said: I will appoint a place for my people Israel, and will plant them, that they may dwell in a place of their own, and move no more; neither shall the children of wickedness afflict them any more, as beforetime.

People are quick to say that every location has allocation. As true as this saying may be, the allocation in every location is exclusively meant for those ordained by God to be there. Indeed, there is a place called "There". Your identity may be that you are the beloved of God, but if you don't stay in your "There", you will end up fending for yourself. Your allocation will only get to you in the allocation the lord has reserved for you. You will find that place in this season in Jesus name.

Jordan of old was a site many people loved to be in. It was that popular. But rather than allow Elijah to head there, God ordered him in 1 Kings 17:3-4 to hide by the brook Cherith, that is before Jordan. And it shall be, that thou shalt drink of the brook; and I have commanded the ravens to feed thee there. When the brook dried up, God commanded him in verse 8 to Arise, get

thee to Zarephath, which belongeth to Zidon, and dwell there: behold, I have commanded a widow woman there to sustain thee. These verses confirm truly that there is an allocation at the location the lord command.

It is against this backcloth that we can better appreciate the first two verses of Psalm 23 which states that *The LORD* is my shepherd; I shall not want. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. When God directs you to a place, you won't lack pasture there. That you are a member of the herd (which is your identity) is immaterial once you toe a path different from the footprints of the shepherd. In fact, you automatically lose your identity in Him when you are not in the territory God wants you to be.

This is why Jesus declared in John 10:27 that *My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me* Beloved, aside the supply which comes with being where God wants you to be per time, the other benefit is protection and exemption. The identity of belonging to the Lord's nation would not have saved any Israelite family who went to sleep over at the house of the Egyptian on the night the angel of death massacred all the first born of Pharaoh's people.

The tragic episode in Exodus 12:29-30 proved that it is all about territory for it says, there was not a house where there was not one dead. Your location per time matters, the lord instructed Moses to take of the blood, and strike it on the

two side posts and on the upper door post of the houses. This identification of their territory was what made the Israelites not to lose their first-borns, not their identity of being people of promise. All the plagues suffered by the Egyptians on account of their refusal to let the Children of Israel go only happened in their parts of the country. Moses' congregation were not affected because they inhabited Goshen. God's people can only dwell in God Reserved Area. Identity and territory go hand in gloves, and in the process guarantee provision and protection.

The handshake between the Israelite's identity and territory under God resulted in Psalm 105:13-16 which read, When they went from one nation to another, from one kingdom to another people; He suffered no man to do them wrong: yea, he reproved kings for their sakes; Saying, Touch not mine anointed, and do my prophets no harm. Moreover he called for a famine upon the land: he brake the whole staff of bread. May your identity always cause you to stay in God Reserved Area so that your provisions and protection can be guaranteed, Amen!
