God wants you to enjoy life. John 10:10b says *I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it [a] overflows) [AMPC]*. God wants your life to overflow to a point where you are so full of life that you become a distributor of it. You carry life and must enjoy this life. Jesus says, I came that you may have life and have it until it overflows. If your neighbor needs life, give it to them and be a distributor of the life of God. But if you want life, you must talk life. You can't talk death and be alive.

You can't talk small and be big. Speak life upon your situation. Proverbs 18:21 says, *Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof*. Those who love what they say shall get the result. What you say is what you see. If you don't say it, you won't see it. Everything has intelligence. Your bank account can hear; the earth and everything in it have ears. The power of death and life is in the tongue. Your tongue can set a whole house on fire. You are where you are today because of what you have been saying. If you care to change your confession, everything will come back to life. If it has to do with very bad situation, then you must speak very loud. When Jesus got to Lazarus' tomb, he shouted Lazarus, come out! If it's very bad, you must speak very loud.

In this month of "I am alive", you cannot afford to be quiet. There is a connection between your tongue and life. The power of death and life is in the tongue. You

must say it very loud so that the people around you can hear it. There are no empty words. Jesus, in John 6:63 said, the words I speak to you are spirit and life. To live and enjoy life, you must watch what you say. Stop speaking death and expect to live.

In fact, when people ask you "how far?" or "how are you?" seize it as an opportunity to prophesy. You can respond to such greetings or enquiry by saying: I am excellent, I am alive, I am blessed, I am great, I am enjoying life, I am well... How are you today? You respond by saying: great things are happening. You are a reflection of your confession. What you say is what you see. *A wholesome tongue is a tree of life, But perverseness in it breaks the spirit, Proverbs 15:4*. Wholesome as used here means a tongue that speaks good things. The tree of life is what Adam and Eve missed in the Garden of Eden, yet we can access this tree by using our tongue the right way.

If you want to enjoy life on earth, speak positivity and avoid negative confessions. Your tongue is very powerful and must not be used anyhow. Many people have spoken things which got them stranded in life. There is a lesson we have to learn from the Shunammite woman, for whom Elisha prayed and she bore a son. She showed great faith in 2 Kings 4:8-37. When the child died, she did not even tell her husband about the loss but went straight in search of Elisha. Even when Elisha saw how her horse galloped and

sent his servant to find out if all was well, the woman said all was well despite losing her son. You won't catch people of faith speaking negative words no matter their circumstance.

Despite Lazarus being dead for four days, Jesus told the grieving sister to only believe and see the glory of God. Your utterance must be consistent with your expectation. Cancel every negative word spoken over your life with positive confessions. The way you say it is how you will see it. This principle is as old as creation. Genesis 1:1-3 reads, *In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness was upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light.*

God called for the appearance of light, when his Spirit was stirred, and He got exactly what He called forth. John 1:1-5 makes us to understand that you speak God when you speak His word. The word of God comes with life which gives light to men and shines in darkness such that darkness cannot comprehend it. We are meant to enjoy life and when we tame our tongue to be wholesome, God's kind of life becomes ours to live. Hallelujah!

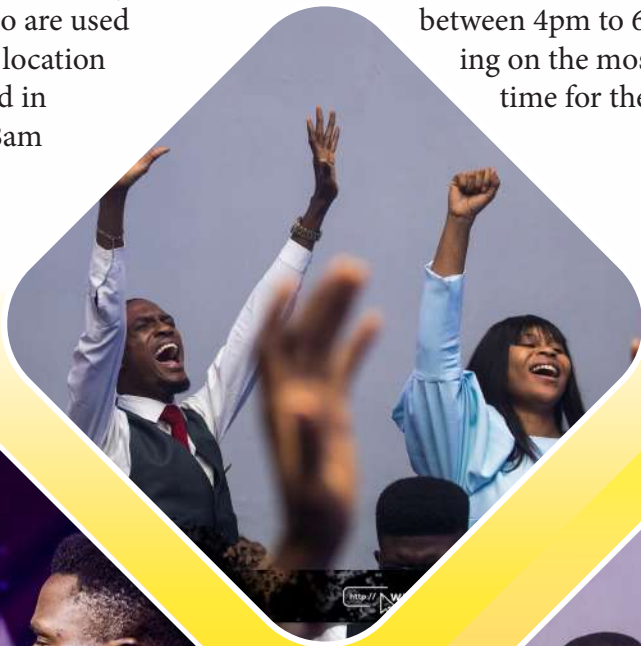
Free Transport Shuttle Still On
