

There is a special spot in life called the *Harm Free Zone (HFZ)*. This is a place where you can step on not just serpents and scorpions but upon all powers of the enemy: yet be unhurt. What this rendering of Luke 10:19 means is that even when you eat food laced with poison, it shall rather bring you nourishment because you are in a zone wherein harm and enchantment cannot survive.

This was the zone of the children of Israel which enabled them to move from one nation to another, from one *kingdom to another people*; and God suffered no man to do them wrong. The Lord went as far as *reproving kings for* their sakes; Saying, Touch not mine anointed, and do my prophets no harm. This Harm Free Zone (HFZ) is actually the Lord's sanctuary where his people are spared of whatever causes hurt or destruction, according to Isaiah 11:9. When God, in Malachi 3:17 promised to spare us as a man spares his own son who serves him, this happens in the Hurt Free Zone.

God desires to spare us from every attack of the enemy because we are the apple of His eyes. Colossians 3:3 unravels the extent of protection we enjoy as God's people. The verse says, *For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.* Dead as used here is explained in Galatians 2:20 thus: *I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and* the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me. With us dead in this sense, our life is now buried with Christ in God. What a way to hide a life! This is in order for us to be exempted from any harm whatsoever.

To get a better grasp of the mystery in Colossians 3:3, consider the verse as an insurance principle that has the insured, the insurer and the re-insurer. Believers are the insured, Christ is the Insurer while God is the re-insurer. So for the devil and his agents to get at us as divinely insured people, he must first prevail over Christ and God, which is even unthinkable. In fact, Jesus has already defeated the devil and he did this in his territory. Remember Colossians 2:15 (Amp): When He had disarmed the rulers and authorities [those supernatural forces of evil operating against us], He made a public example of them [exhibiting them as captives in His triumphal procession], having triumphed over them through the cross.

As robust as the insurance talked about in Colossians 3:3, it is amazing that it does not require any other premium than to accept the insurer – Jesus Christ – as our Lord and personal saviour, and we are covered forever. A believer's life is truly insured in Christ. On the strength of this insurance which places her in the Harm Free Zone, she cannot be destroyed or be swayed by intimidating threats. Praise the Lord for we have double insurance cover as the apple of God's eyes. We have been insured by Christ and reinsured in God so that no harm or evil can get to us.

With such a bulwark, whoever is threatening us or whatever concerns us does not know what they are up against. Before the enemy can attack us, they must first contend with Christ and God. Who can battle with the Lord? The popular chorus correctly answers that nobody can. But to enjoy this Colossians 3:3 insurance, Psalm 91 must be our anchor. The key to this particular psalm can be found in verses 1 and 2 thus: He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.

You can't be under the shadow of the Almighty and be tormented by principalities. No diabolic missile can make it to the Harm Free Zone. Verse 9-11 of the same Psalm 91 continue, Because thou hast made the Lord, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation; There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. My beloved, accept Jesus Christ today so that you can be in HFZ and enjoy its impregnable cover.
