

low-life seeking a place in the palace must consciously spite his or her poor background and front favour. This was the attitude adopted by Esther to become the first lady of a vast empire where she was brought in as a slave girl. Through the guidance of her cousin, Mordecai, she overcame her understandable inferiority complex to join a pageantry in which she won the heart of King Xerxes.

Esther 2:7 introduces us to this paragon of beauty burdened with a rough background. She was an orphan whose older cousin was kind enough to adopt. As if things weren't bad enough, Mordecai and Esther were taken into captivity when King Nebuchadnezzar invaded Jerusalem where they live. Mordecai became a slave in a foreign land which made Esther the adopted younger cousin of a slave.

But verse 8 tells us about the advert announcing the king's search for a wife. Beautiful ladies were requested to participate in a pageantry for this purpose. Esther 2:8b says, *Esther also was taken to the king's palace and entrusted to Hegai, who had charge of the harem.* This suggested that Esther, despite her beauty, did not consider herself good enough for this competition for the king's attention but had to be *taken* to the palace by her guardian, who was a gateman, in the palace.

Mordecai kept telling her to apply as she's got what it takes. You must be wary of defeatist mentality. Never confess that you are not able. Philippians 4:13 which says I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me? As a born again, you can do all things with the exception of none. If you are from a disadvantaged background, all you need to do is to apply the wisdom in Esther 2:10, *Esther had not revealed her nationality and family background, because Mordecai had forbidden her to do so.*

Her wise uncle advised her not to reveal that she is an alien but to let the king marry her before she reveals where she hails from. Never start a relationship by telling your suitor everything about your past for you risk chasing him away. It is like making presentation to a prospect and you did not start from your strongest point. The shocker is that the person you are confessing your ugly past to has a worst background.

You should only open up to the person you are dating only when you trust him enough with your life. Don't negotiate from a weak point; start from a strong point instead. When you confess your limitations so soon, you shut down opportunities even though you've got what it takes for the role. A child of God should not have inferiority complex for no one is better than you. You have the mind of Christ which makes you able and super intelligent. Never talk down on yourself.

The moment Hegai saw Esther, the eunuch was pleased with her and decided to favour her. Verse 9 continues, *immediately he*

provided her with her beauty treatments and special food. Her assigned to her seven female attendants selected for the king's palace and moved her and her attendants into the best place in the harem [NIV]. He already saw her as the wife material for his king.

Esther wouldn't have got all these privileges if she had disclosed her identity. If she did, she wouldn't even have made it to the harem. Another lesson from this is that you must talk less. Since she was not asked of her nationality and background, she did not reveal that aspect out of inferiority complex or to play the sympathy card. Hegai could not have settled for Esther out of empathy for her plight. He only did because she carried herself with self-worth and confidence.

Proverbs 23:7 warns that, as *a man thinketh in his heart, so is he.* You cannot fail in life until you've seen yourself as failure in the mind. Your low upbringing is nothing compared to the glorious future ahead of you as a child of God. Spite your background today so that your back won't remain on the ground.


